**Traveling South on Hwy 1**

- **Follow Hwy 1 SOUTH** past Fort Ord, Seaside and part of Monterey.
- Take the "**Munras Ave. and Soledad St.**" Exit.
- Continue straight on Soledad through the traffic light, crossing Munras Ave.
- Just beyond the intersection, take an immediate **RIGHT onto Pacific Street.**
- Stay on Pacific Street to **Scott Street**, turn **LEFT** onto Scott Street.
- From Scott, turn **RIGHT into the public parking lot** (2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> levels are best). No need to go to the attendant.
- Park your car anywhere you like – closest to the "Bridge" sign is best. **Follow the signs to the foot "Bridge,"** which crosses over Pacific Street.
- **Walk across the Bridge**, go down the stairway - veer to your left at the water fountain.
- Our offices are located in the last building on your left. Look for door with "Monterey Bay Aquarium, Suite 100A" – if you reach the recreation trail or the harbor you have gone too far.
- We will provide a complimentary parking pass for the parking garage when departing.
