


PINE RANCH CASE HISTORY

Pine Ranch Case History/Summary

- A. Aug 8th 2009-** Matthew Pine was cited by Warden Brett Gomes for taking quail out of season T14 300(a)(1)(E)(1) ; Jeremiah Cummins was cited by Warden Sen Pirtle for failing to tag and document a deer FG 4336(a) (both convicted on plea of guilty in Colusa County). Multiple other individuals were found to be hunting on the Pine Ranch while using A Zone deer tags.
- B. April 2010-** Mark Pine received a letter from CA Dept. of Fish and Wildlife notifying him the Pine Ranch PLM had been placed on probation for the violations that occurred on the Pine Ranch on Aug 8th 2009
- C. Aug 23rd 2013-** Matthew Pine, Daniel Levitt, Clayton Samaniego and Kevin Broderick were cited by Wardens Trunnell, Keiser and Shelton for spotlighting FG 2005(b) (received court diversion, which was completed on March 12th 2014 and charges were dismissed).
- Oct 2013-** Mark Pine was notified by the PLM program that the Pine Ranch PLM had been suspended due to the violations occurring on Aug 23rd, 2013.
- D. Dec 2013-** Mark Pine received a letter from CA Dept. of Fish and Wildlife notifying him the Department was recommending the Pine Ranch PLM be revoked by the Fish and Game Commission.
- Feb 5th 2014-** Pine Ranch PLM was revoked permanently from the PLM program by the Fish and Game Commission due the violations occurring in Aug 2009 and Aug 2013.
- E. March 21st 2014-** A search warrant issued by Yolo County Superior Court was served at the Pine residence in Alamo CA and the Pine Ranch, in connection to Matthew Pine failing to tag and document a deer he had killed on the Pine Ranch on July 13th, 2013.
- Matthew Pine was interviewed on the Pine Ranch and provided statements confirming he had killed a deer in July 2013 and had failed to tag or document the deer. He offered to retrieve the antlers from the untagged deer and turn them over within the week to Wildlife Officers.
- F. April 15th 2014-** After Matthew Pine had failed to turn over the antlers from the deer he killed on July 13th 2013, a letter was sent to Matthew Pine's attorney demanding Matthew Pine to provide the antlers to Wildlife Officers for inspection per FG 2012.
- G. May 2014-** After Matthew Pine turned over the antlers from the deer he had killed, charges were filed against him in Yolo County Superior Court for failing to tag and document a deer FG 4336(a) and unlawfully possessing the deer FG 2002.



1 On 8-8-09 at Warden Pirtle and I were on the Hayes Ranch in Colusa County checking deer hunting
 2 activity. At approximately 9:00 A.M. we both heard a single rifle shot. We both agreed that the shot location
 3 was probably from the Pine Ranch. We entered the Pine Ranch and were able to locate the hunting cabins/
 4 trailers located on the east side of the ranch at approximately 1:05 P.M.. Warden Pirtle and I exited his
 5 vehicle and approached a trailer with a few occupants inside. Matthew Pine exited the trailer and I asked him
 6 who shot the deer. Matthew Pine indicated his friend had and his friend was in the skinning shed to the west
 7 of our location. Warden Pirtle and I walked back towards Warden Pirtle's vehicle and I noticed two Valley
 8 Quail lying on the windshield of a Jeep which was parked in front of the trailer we had just departed. I asked
 9 who shot the quail and Matthew indicated he had. Warden Pirtle drove to the skinning shed while I secured
 10 the two quail. Matthew Pine and I walked to the skinning shed. The deer that was being skinned had not been
 11 tagged as required by state law. Warden Pirtle cited the subject who took the deer and I cited Matthew Pine
 12 for taking two quail during the closed season. I also seized the two quail.

On August 2009, at approximately 0900 hours, Warden Brett Gomes and I (Warden Sean Pirtle) were on patrol on the Hayes Ranch near the Colusa/Yolo County Lines off of Road 57. We heard a gunshot at this time and heard a distinct "thump" immediately after the shot indicating someone had hit a large animal with a high powered rifle. This shot came from the adjacent ranch known as the Pine Ranch. This was the opening day of the general rifle deer season in deer zone A. Warden Gomes and I finished checking hunters on the Hayes Ranch and went to investigate the shot we heard on the Pine Ranch.

We entered the Pine Ranch and made contact with Connor Pine whose father Mark Pine owns the ranch. Connor advised he was not hunting but his brother and some friends were hunting on the ranch. We later determined they were staying at a house on the lower end of the ranch near County Line Road. Warden Gomes and I drove through the Pine Ranch and located the lower houses on the ranch at approximately 1305 hours. The houses are located in Colusa County. We made contact with several subjects who advised one of their group of hunters had killed a deer and was now skinning the deer in the skinning shed.

I drove over to their skinning shed and made contact with a subject identified as JEREMIAH DESMOND CUMMINS. CUMMINS was actively skinning a 2X2 buck deer. I asked CUMMINS if he had killed the deer and he stated yes. I asked if he possessed a deer tag for the deer. CUMMINS stated yes, but he had not filled it out yet. CUMMINS walked out to an ATV and recovered a deer tag from a back-pack. He handed the tag to me and asked if I wanted him to fill it out. I advised it was a little late to do this activity as the law requires a person to immediately fill out a deer tag after killing a deer. I noted the deer tag report card section had CUMMINS' personal information written on it but nothing else on the entire deer tag had been filled out and the notches for the month and day of kill had not been removed as required by State Law.

CUMMINS asked for a warning regarding the violation. I advised CUMMINS that I heard the shot when he shot this deer at 0900 hours this morning and it was now 1305. CUMMINS stated yes, I killed the deer around 0900 hours this morning. This gave him over four hours to fill out his deer tag and he had not done this activity as required by law. This included gutting the deer, transporting the deer to the cabin, and beginning to skin the deer without filling out the deer tag. I advised it is not that difficult to fill out and cut the notches on the deer tag after killing a deer. CUMMINS stated that he understood.


I asked the elder Pine son if the ranch was enrolled in the Private Lands Management Program through the Department of Fish & Game. Pine advised it was enrolled in the PLM program, but they had not obtained their PLM tags yet this year. I advised him that general A zone deer tags are not valid on this ranch if it is enrolled in the PLM program. Pine stated he was not aware of this information. Note that Warden Gomes found Pine to be in possession of two valley quail he had taken during closed season.

I issued citation #AD1817375 to CUMMINS for violation of Fish & Game Code section 4336- failure to fill out and remove notches for month and day of kill on deer tag immediately after killing deer.

I seized one 2X2 buck deer and one A zone deer tag #504387-06 from CUMMINS.

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

Subject: Fish and Game violations on the Pine Ranch PLM

Dear Mr. Pine,

The Department of Fish and Game has been notified of violations that occurred on Pine Ranch during the opening weekend of the A zone in 2009. Two individuals were given citations, one for being in possession of two out of season valley quail and the other for being in possession of an un-tagged deer. The warden also reported that 3 or 4 individuals were hunting on the ranch using A zone deer tags which is in violation of the PLM agreement.

Due to these violations, the Department of Fish and Game is placing the Pine Ranch PLM on probation for a one year period. During this period, any additional violations of PLM regulations and/or policies may result in reduced tag authorization or a Department recommendation to revoke the PLM license. Title 14, CCR, Section 601 describes the requirements and provisions of the PLM Program.

Mr. Pine,

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) has been notified of violations that occurred on the Pine Ranch Private Lands Management Area (PLM) on August 23, 2013. Four individuals were stopped by California Department of Fish and Wildlife's Wildlife Officers and cited for spotlighting (Fish and Game Code 2005b). Each suspect was carrying a loaded weapon capable of killing big game. This is the second violation on the ranch in three years. The prior citation took place in 2009 which resulted in Pine Ranch receiving a probation letter in April 2010. Both violations have resulted in citations for the owner's son, Matthew Pine, who has been on yearly site visits and is aware of the PLM Regulations.

In late October the Department contacted you to inform you of our decision to revoke your remaining 2013 PLM deer tags (Title 14, CCR, 601(e)(2)) and an attempt to collect the tags was unsuccessful. Per your 2013 PLM License Agreement all PLM tags, exchange tags, log sheets and the 2013 Harvest Report must be submitted to the Department by December 31, 2013. Please mail all documents to: Wildlife Branch Attn: Victoria Barr 1812 Ninth St, Sacramento, CA 95811.

Due to these violations, the Department will recommend the PLM license for Pine Ranch be revoked by the Fish and Game Commission. You will be notified of the commission meeting the Pine Ranch PLM license will be discussed, at which time you may contest our decision.

9 a Game Warden in Yolo, Solano and Sacramento Counties and have been in this
10 position for over two years.

11 During my employment, I have investigated a variety of fish and game violations.
12 These cases have involved the unlawful taking and possession of fish and wildlife,
13 including, but not limited to deer, bear, upland game, waterfowl, and fish. Many of these
14 cases have involved deer violations. The following information has come to my attention
15 while in the lawful performance of my duties as a California State Game Warden, which
16 leads me to believe that Matthew Pine is involved in the unlawful taking of deer.

17 On 08/23/2013, Matthew Pine was contacted on the Pine Ranch, located 10
18 miles west of Dunnigan and 3 miles east of Guinda in Yolo County, by Wardens
19 Trunnel, Keiser, and Shelton after being observed violating FG 2005(b); Spotlighting.
20 During the enforcement contact, Matthew Pine was in possession of two unfilled
21 California deer tags; #D-0008444099-8 and #D-0008562029-2. California Code of
22 Regulations Title 14 section 708.1(a) allows for a person to take no more than two deer
23 a year. Individuals are only allowed to buy and possess two deer tags a year. The two
24 tags Matthew Pine possessed represented the two deer he is allowed to harvest for the
25 year. The two deer tags were photographed and Matthew Pine was cited and released
26 for violating FG 2005(b).

27 During the month of November 2013, it came to my attention that Matthew Pine
28 had possibly killed a deer in July 2013. After visiting off-safety.com, an internet site

1 documenting the hunting activity of Matthew Pine and several other persons, I observed
2 a photograph of Matthew Pine with a dead deer, and a narrative describing the hunt in
3 which Matthew Pine killed the deer. The same photo of Matthew Pine and the deer can
4 also be found on Matthew Pine's personal Instragram web page. I inspected the
5 photographs. Matthew Pine was holding the antlers of a dead deer 2x2. A 2x2 buck is
6 a male deer that has two points on the upper portion of both antlers. The antlers of the
7 deer still contained their velvet layer; signifying the deer was killed prior to August, the
8 typical time a deer loses the velvet from its antlers. The photo from Matthew Pine's
9 Instragram page was uploaded on 07/14/13, and the narrative form offsafty.com
10 describes the deer being killed on 07/13/13. All three sites are accessible by the general
11 public with not special passwords or accounts needed to view them.

12 Matthew Pine was previously cited in August 2009 on the Pine Ranch by Warden
13 Gomes for possessing an untagged deer. During the multiple enforcement contacts of
14 Matthew Pine hunting on the Pine Ranch, he had informed the Wardens he has full
15 access to the entire property, in which his parents own. He travels to the ranch for
16 multiple days at a time, lodging and keeping property at the main hunting cabin on the
17 property. Of the two deer tags Matthew Pine possessed on 08/23/13, one was a PLM
18 (Private Land Management) tag issued for the Pine Ranch. Per the department's PLM
19 agreement with the Pine Ranch, the property boundaries is described on the attached
20 document.

21 During the course of my investigation, I ran a D.M.V. records check on Matthew
22 Pine. According to D.M.V. records, Matthew Pine has a valid driver's license and a
23 residence at [REDACTED] California. Matthew
24 Pine's vehicle, a 2012 black Chevrolet Silverado #34941j1, is registered to his name
25 and an address of [REDACTED]. Also the address on [REDACTED] was provided
26 by Matthew Pine as his residence when buying tags and licenses through the
27 department's automated licensing data system. On 12/02/2013, I observed both
28 Matthew Pine and his Chevrolet Silverado at the address on [REDACTED].

1 All deer seasons in the Sacramento Valley have closed by November 3, 2013.
2 According to Fish and Game Code section 2001(c) and section 3080, it is unlawful to
3 possess deer after the close of the season unless it is properly documented in
4 accordance with section 3080. Section 3080 states the possessor of deer needs to
5 have a hunting license and validated tag, or a photocopy of the donor's hunting license
6 and tag, or a signed and dated document confirming the donation with the donors
7 name, address, hunting license number, and tag number.

8 Based on my training and experience, I have found that hunters, who unlawfully
9 kill deer, will often keep some or all of the parts of the deer at their residences in storage
10 areas, coolers, totes, refrigerators, and freezers to preserve it for human consumption. I
11 have found that deer hunters who kill a male deer will retain the antlers and store them
12 in their residences, garages, barns, sheds, freezers, and trees. I have found that is
13 common that hunters will keep the consumable deer parts for upwards of one year after
14 killing the deer and they will keep the antlers for upwards of several years.

15 Based on my training, experience, and the facts contained within this affidavit, I
16 believe Matthew Pine killed a deer on July 13th, 2013 and failed to tag or document the
17 deer. My Matthew Pine being in possession of his two and only unfilled deer tags in
18 August, it is not possible for him to have tagged and documented a deer killed in July. I
19 believe there is more than a reasonable expectation that Matthew Pine possesses deer
20 meat and parts that are not accompanied with valid deer tag, thereby using the same as
21 means of committing a public offense, to wit, violation of Fish and Game Code sections
22 2001(c) and 3080, *Dunn v. Municipal Court* (1963) 220 Cal.App.2d 858, and request the
23 authorization of this warrant for:

Dear Mr. Lansburgh:

On March 21, 2014, several wildlife officers with the Department of Fish and Wildlife contacted and spoke with your client, Mr. Matthew Pine, while he was on his family's ranch in Yolo County. During their conversation, Mr. Pine told the officers that he had killed a deer on July 13, 2013 while hunting on the ranch. The officers informed Mr. Pine that an investigation was being conducted regarding the killing and tagging of the deer. When asked about the whereabouts of the antlers of the deer he had killed, Mr. Pine stated they were with his friend. Mr. Pine agreed to cooperate in the investigation by offering to retrieve the antlers and turn them over to officers for inspection. To date, no wildlife officer has heard back from Mr. Pine regarding the antlers.

As a wildlife officer authorized to enforce the Fish and Game Code, I am now making a formal demand, pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 2012, for Mr. Matthew Pine to provide for my inspection, the antlers or any other parts of the deer he killed on or about July 13, 2013, and to also provide me with any and all of his deer tags from the 2013 deer season, including but not limited to any A Zone deer tag or PLM deer tag in his possession. Failure to comply with this demand may result in criminal charges being filed against Mr. Pine for violation of Fish and Game Code section 2012.

Fish and Game Code section 2012 provides: "All licenses, tags, and the birds, mammals, fish, reptiles, or amphibians taken or otherwise dealt with under this code, and any device or apparatus designed to be, and capable of being, used to take birds, mammals, fish, reptiles, or amphibians shall be exhibited upon demand to any person authorized by the department to enforce this code or any law relating to the protection and conservation of birds, mammals, fish, reptiles, or amphibians." The Department's PLM program has not received any deer tags or reporting information associated with the Pine Ranch, including any deer tag issued to Mr. Pine. I hope Mr. Pine will comply with my demand and continue to cooperate with me in this investigation.

Mr. Pine has until April 29, 2014 to provide me with the antlers and deer tags that I have requested. Please contact me at (530) 604-9788 to make the necessary arrangements.
