1. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ADOPTION OF PROPOSED CHANGES TO APRIL 2014 OCEAN SALMON SPORT FISHING REGULATIONS AND POSSESSION LIMIT. (SUBSECTIONS 27.80(c) AND (e), TITLE 14)
Executive Director Mastrup introduced and summarized that this item was for adoption of proposed ocean salmon sportfishing regulations for conformance with federal regulations to establish open fishing days, bag limits and minimum size restrictions for April 2014 and to increase the salmon possession limit. Barry Miller gave an oral presentation and written copies of the presentation were available at all notice locations. Received public testimony.
