Dear Commissioners,

The Santa Cruz Harbor Port Commission is discriminating against anglers based on racism and elitism. The harbor is outlawing fishing for returning king salmon.

These salmon have been planted by a volunteer enhancement effort and the shore based anglers are not being allowed to catch them. On tuesday night I will be going to the fourth harbor meeting to plead our case. The commission has not been receptive to calls for co operation. After the last meeting I was qouted in the local paper and received a threatening phone call from the director of the Santa Cruz Harbor the morning it was published.

I appreciate the work you all are doing for the anglers of Manhattan Beach Pier and the case here in Santa Cruz is very similar. I would be happy to speak or write to anybody that can offer their assistance to the cause.
