Please advise Commission Members that NCCIFFF representatives are, regrettably, unable to attend the Commission's August 6 meeting in San Diego. We are all volunteers, all from northern California, often pay our own travel and lodging costs and need reasonable advance notice in order to be able to schedule such meetings. At the Commission's October Mt. Shasta meeting we will be prepared to speak to the Salmon Policy topic outlined in the Commission's Agenda Item 1 for the San Diego meeting. We respectfully request fifteen minutes on the Mt. Shasta Agenda to discuss our Management Plan proposal.

We continue to advocate development and implementation of Management Plans for California's Anadromous fishery rivers. We appreciate the Department's important step this year in funding a sonar fish count on the Smith River. The data this study develops, coupled with an updating of the 2002 "Smith River Anadromous Fish Action Plan," can lead logically to timely development of a Management Plan for the Smith. That plan can act as a template for development of similar management plans for other of California's anadromous fishery rivers.

We look forward to partnering with your Commission and the Department in finding funding sources, developing budgets, locating qualified authors and moving development of a statewide series of anadromous fishery management plans forward.
