Dear Mr. Lehr,

This letter is sent in preparation for the Fish and Game Commission meeting on Feb. 12, 2015 regarding fishing regulations.

I support a number of practices to preserve the salmon and trout in the Klamath River, as well as, to reduce waste and harmful fishing. I commend the Yurok's attempts to do so. I suggest the following for consideration:

- 1) No catch and release fishing at all on the Klamath River.
- 2) Once an angler catches 2 fish in the Klamath River, then he stops fishing. He is not allowed to move up/down river and catch more fish. The daily total is 2 fish only per adult.
- 3) No snagging is allowed.
- 4) At any time the river temperature reaches 70 degrees F or above, all fishing stops in the Klamath River.
- 5) I support the closure of Blue Creek and any other location viable for the preservation of fish stocks.
- 6) Any and all gill net fishing is ruled illegal.
- 7) Re-evaluation of hatchery management by the DFW as it is being poorly handled and needs improvement.
- 8) Provide adequate enforcement of the regulations with appropriate penalties.
