Hello

I have a concern about the maximum preference point number for sheep, elk and antelope. Because there are so few of these tags given anyone that is behind even one point essentially has no chance of ever being a max point applicant. In other states like Colorado, which much of our preference point system was based on, the species that have very few tags like goats, sheep, moose, etc have cap on the maximum number of points a person can obtain. I look at my son who is just starting hunting. While he will have some excellent oppportunities as a junior hunter once he turns 18 he may never realistically have a shot at a sheep, elk or antelope tag. Enough people get deer tags so the max points will always cycle through for them but for the other species there really should be a modification. I know several hunters that would typically put in for these 3 species but they are down a point or two for various reasons so they have given up. I have heard that a points cap has been discussed. I sure hope it happens so new hunters in the state will be able to compete for these tags at some point in their life.
