Background

Under the Bagley-Keene Act, FGC cannot act on any matter not included on the agenda, except to schedule issues raised by the public for consideration at future meetings. FGC generally receives three types of correspondence: Requests for regulatory action, requests for non-regulatory action, and informational only. The Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires action on regulatory requests to be either denied or granted and notice made of that determination. At the end of public forum a motion may be made to provide direction to staff on any items for which FGC wishes to receive additional information or take immediate action. Otherwise, FGC will determine the fate of the regulatory and non-regulatory requests at the next FGC meeting to allow staff time to evaluate requests.
