Jim Kellogg of Discovery Bay was appointed to FGC on January 31, 2002 by Governor Davis. He was reappointed by governor's Schwarzenegger and Brown, serving the longest term of any commissioner in FGC's history He has served as president and vice president of FGC as well as co-chair for the Wildlife Resources Committee. He resigned in December 2015.

Richard Rogers of Santa Barbara was appointed to FGC on January 18, 2005 by Governor Schwarzenegger. He has served as president and vice president of FGC as well as co-chair for the Marine Resources Committee. He served until July 6, 2015.

Michael Sutton of Monterey was appointed to FGC on May 3, 2007 by Governor Schwarzenegger. He has served as president and vice president of FGC as well as co-chair for the Marine Resources Committee. He served until July 6, 2015.

Jack Baylis of Los Angeles was appointed to FGC on September 29, 2010 by Governor Schwarzenegger and confirmed by the State Senate in September 2011. He has served as president and vice president of FGC as well as co-chair for the Wildlife Resources Committee. His term expired January 16, 2016.

Sonke Mastrup became executive director of FGC on July 8, 2011 after working in the natural resources field for the previous 33 years. Before joining FGC he worked for the California Department of Fish and Game (now DFW), the last ten years of which were as deputy executive director under four directors and three governors. He left FGC in December 2015 to take a management position with DFW's Marine Region.
