



# Total Reported CDFW Licensed Trapper Take for Eight Furbearing and Nongame Species: 1980-2015

★ As of November 20, 2015, no recreational trapping of bobcat is allowed.




## Total Take for Four Furbearing and Nongame Species as Reported in the CDFW Game Take Hunter Survey for the Years: 1980-2015



## Total Take for Bobcat as Reported through CDFW Mandatory Hunt Tag Returns for the Years: 1980-2015



## Results of the 2015 Responsive Management Survey: “Harvest of Small Game, Upland Birds, and Other Wildlife in California”

- For coyote, gray fox and American crow, Responsive Management attempted to separate those animals killed as part of property protection from those killed during hunts.





\*Although the analysis attempted to separate coyotes killed for property protection and those killed during hunts, there was still overlap between the two that could not be resolved; for this reason, the sum of the number killed for property protection and the number killed during hunts slightly exceeds the number killed statewide.




## Distribution of Badgers Taken by Trappers and Hunters

for the Years: 1990 - 2015




Average Badger Take by County

for the Years: 1994-2008 & 2010




## Distribution of Bobcats Taken by Trappers and Hunters

for the Years:1990 - 2015




Average Bobcat Take by County as Reported by

Over the Years: 1990-2015




## Distribution of Coyotes Taken by Trappers and Hunters

for the Years: 1990 - 2015




Average Coyote Take by County

for the Years: 1990 - 2008 & 2010




## Distribution of Gray Fox Taken by Trappers and Hunters

for the Years: 1990 - 2015




Average Gray Fox Take by County

for the Years: 1994 - 2008 & 2010




## Distribution of Raccoons Taken by Trappers and Hunters

for the Years: 1990 - 2015




Average Raccoon Take by County
