REGULATORY TEXT

Section 507, Title 14, CCR, is amended to read as follows:

§507. Provisions Related to the Taking of Migratory Game Birds.

- (a) Authorized Methods. Only the following methods may be used to take migratory game birds:
- (1) Falconry.
- (2) Bow and Arrows or Crossbows. Only arrows or <u>crossbows crossbow</u> bolts with fluflu fletching may be used except that conventionally fletched arrows may be used to take waterfowl sitting on the water from scullboats or similar watercraft. Archers hunting during any archery season may not possess a firearm while in the field engaged in archery hunting.
