**ADDENDUM TO FINAL STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR REGULATORY ACTION**

Amend Section 550, 550.5, 551, 552, 630 and 702, and  
Repeal Subsections 703(a)(2) and 703(c),  
Title 14, California Code of Regulations

Re: Department of Fish and Wildlife Lands Pass Program and Lands Public Uses

V. Update:

1. **During initial review of the final statement of reasons by the Office of Administrative Law (OAL), a number of non-substantive changes and typographical corrections were recommended and subsequently made to the regulation text, and the initial statement of reasons (ISOR) was amended to improve explanatory text, and correct grammar and punctuation. In addition, several changes were made that were sufficiently related to the original text that it was apparent the changes could result from the originally proposed regulatory action. A 15-day notice of all these changes and corrections were made available to the public, with all changes clearly indicated in the full text of the proposed regulatory action.**
2. **The 15-day notice was mailed to interested and affected parties on February 17, 2017 with the amended regulation text and amended ISOR; proposed changes were identified in double underline and double strikethrough. The notice, amended regulation text and amended ISOR are added to the file index as items 2, 2.a. and 2.b. No public comments were received during the February 20, 2017 through March 6, 2017 comment period.**
3. **Updates to Authority and Reference Citations Based on Recent Legislation. Senate Bill 1473 (Stats. 2016, Ch. 546) made organizational changes to the Fish and Game Code that became effective January 1, 2017. The changes included moving the Commission's exemptions from specified Administrative Procedure Act time frames from Section 202 to Section 265 of the Fish and Game Code, and moving the Commission's authority to adopt emergency regulations from Section 240 to Section 399 of the Fish and Game Code; these were organizational changes only. In accordance with these changes to the Fish and Game Code, Sections 202 is removed from, and Sections 265 is added to, the authority and reference citations for sections 550, 551, 552, 630 and 702 of Title 14.**
