15-Day Continuation Notice of California Notice Register 2016, No. Z2016-0425-02 Re: Department of Fish and Wildlife Lands Pass Program and Land Public Uses

TO ALL INTERESTED AND AFFECTED PARTIES:

This is to provide you with a 15-day continuation notice of the notice of proposed regulatory action to amend sections 550, 550.5, 551, 552, 630 and 702, and repeal subsections 703(a)(2) and 703(c), Title 14, California Code of Regulations, regarding Department of Fish and Wildlife Lands Pass Program and Land Public Uses, which was published in the California Regulatory Notice Register on May 6, 2016. The proposed changes to the originally noticed language are shown in double underline/strikeout underline and are sufficiently related to the originally proposed text.

The changes reflect clarification to the regulation text, necessity statement, other clarifying statements, and minor editorial changes. The deadline for receipt of written comments on the revised proposed regulatory language is **5:00 p.m. on March 6, 2017**.
